The Phoebe A Hearst Parent Teacher Organization (PTO) is a volunteer group of parents, guardians, teachers and staff of Phoebe Hearst Elementary School.

We are dedicated to enriching your child's educational journey in many ways, including financial support for the Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math program, the visual arts program, and music program, field trips, classroom support, campus beautification and so much more.

Support provided by the PTO enables our teachers to focus on the business of educating.

PTO involvement is open to all parents and guardians of PH students.

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The PTO works hand-in-hand with teachers, school staff and administrators.

The support provided is in alignment with school priorities.

School teachers and staff work with us to guide how we can best support classrooms, students and our school community.



Let's walk through how the PTO is structured.

The PTO Board is led by elected members, who are parents & guardians of Phoebe Hearst students. We are joined by the school principal and two teacher representatives. Board elections are held once per year.

The PTO Board also includes numerous committee chairs and committee members that plan and carry out fundraising events, enrichment events, campus beautification and safety efforts and other program program support.

Many of the elected Board Members also serve on event & activity committees and volunteer on campus.

With the support of Phoebe families, the PTO organizes robust fundraising efforts that contribute to the many cherished educational and enrichment programs at our school.

Our marquee fundraising events are the Jog-A-Thon in the fall and The Event auction gala in the spring. These large events are supplemented by many small fundraisers like monthly dine & donates, Kona Ice sales, dollar free dress days, pie and candy sales, grant writing efforts and more.

These fundraising efforts fully fund Phoebe's art program, and contribute to the music, STEM and garden programs, the many fieldtrips our students attend, campus beautification efforts, outdoor learning space support, enrichment dollars for the classrooms, an impressive send-off for our 6th graders each year, and so much more.

PTO members also plan and carry out many beloved enrichment activities for our wider school community, such as the Homerun Reader Program, the Harvest Festival, Skate Night, Ice Cream Social for Kinder families, Movie Night, Science Night and more!

We also support efforts to recognize our amazing teachers and staff and support them to make their magic happen!

CLOSE COLLAB WITH SCHOOL

We work in close collaboration with school administration, staff and teachers.

For clarity about who to go to with questions on any given topic, this is a quick illustration of who primarily leads various school-related programs and activities.

For example, if I have a question or comment about Science Night, Homerun Reader or Kona Ice fundraising, I'd contact the PTO.

If I have a question about spirit week or Back to School night, I'll ask school staff.

The PTO is entirely a volunteer-run organization.

Phoebe Hearst parents and guardians are welcome and encouraged to get involved.

There are different levels of involvement.

Many of you have probably already started by lending a hand - helping as a yard duty, garden, crosswalk, or classroom volunteer.

We also need event and activity helpers. These are the committee members that help plan and carry out things like Skate Night, Science Night and Jog-A-Thon.

The event & activity chairs lead the committees in planning and carrying out these efforts.

The elected PTO members work to ensure our efforts are in alignment with state & local policies, and with school priorities, financial needs, and future plans. We work to communicate PTO goings-on with our school community, and we work to ensure we are strategic and responsible stewards of funds raised by the PTO and Phoebe families.
